

Pedestrian Crossings

Types – Uncontrolled Zebra - Controlled Pelican – Flashing amber – same as zebra crossing.
Puffin / Toucan / Pegasus Normal traffic light sequence School crossing

Planning and Anticipation – MSPSL Are there any pedestrians crossing or waiting to cross

Priority – Zebra – Must give way to pedestrians crossing or waiting to cross. Other – Obey lights

Where to Stop – Behind give way / stop line Handbrake – Neutral

Where NOT to Stop – Do NOT block crossing even if no pedestrians treat as box junction

Courtesy – Invitation – Do not invite people to cross there may be other vehicles you have not seen. Harassment – Do not intimidate pedestrians with the following - Flash lights / Horn / revving engine

When to go – Only go when pedestrians have completely cleared the crossing if crossing has central refuge this can be treated as two separate crossings

Zigzag Lines – No overtaking moving vehicles (except cyclists) No parking – Pedestrians view obstructed!

Other Crossings – Centre island – Lowered kerb – Speed humps

Be aware of pedestrians but they do not have priority!
